Skills Education

Master the skills you need to live independently through group and one-on-one sessions with our trained specialists, certified vision rehabilitation therapist, and certified orientation and mobility instructors.

- Rehabilitative Skills focus on adaptive physical functions.
- Orientation and Mobility Skills focus on understanding your surroundings and how to navigate between familiar locations.
- Technology Skills focus on smart resources that bring greater ease to your everyday life.
- General Life Skills focus on your critical non-physical abilities.
